JOHN BOHLER (TRUMPET) – John is an engineer by day and active trumpet player most nights and weekends. He teaches privately and has played with many groups in the Cleveland area including jazz, rock, local theater, church and classical settings.

DOUG DAY (BASS GUITAR) – Doug is retired from his position as Band and Orchestra Director at Bay Village High School. Doug has played piano, trombone and bass professionally for over 50 years, including eight years as the bassist for the Harry Hershey Orchestra. Presently is the pianist for the Cleveland Tops Swingband, Backspin Rhythm and Horns and Avon Lake Presbyterian Church. He is married to Jackie and has two kids.

MIKE ELKINS (KEYBOARD) – Mike is a pianist, saxophonist, flutist and arranger. He is the music director and primary arranger for 3 Birds and the Wire, a relatively new musical group on the Cleveland music scene. He is or has been a member of several area big bands, including Swing Era Big Band, Strongsville City Jazz, Jim's Little Big Band, The Dan Zola Orchestra, and the former Swing City big band. He has performed in pit bands and done music direction at Beck Center, the Mandel JCC, Clague Playhouse, Cassidy Theater, and the former Berea Summer Theater at Baldwin Wallace University.

He taught junior high and high school band and orchestra in Summit County for 15 years. He has spent 60+ years performing with a wide variety of musical groups, including the Front Row Theater, Blossom Music Center, and the Cleveland TOPS Band.

Today, Bob can be found performing with the Cleveland Guardians Dixieland Band at home games - a role he especially enjoys. He also loves sharing his music through performances at private venues and special events. Beyond music, he treasures time with his lovely wife, Aloise, his family, and travel. Bob is honored to be part of this production and looks forward to sharing the joy of 70's music with the Strongsville Community Theater audience.

SCOTT HALM (SCT SINGER) – Scott is excited to be a part of this great team of musicians, and he thanks you for supporting this show and all live music. 
